Clean & Empty
Replace lids & caps

METAL

Steel & Aluminum Containers and Foil



Cardboard (flattened), Office Paper, Newspaper, Magazines









GLASS

Containers: Bottles & Jars Only

PLASTIC

Containers: Bottles, Tubs, Jugs, and Jars Only



No Plastic Bags No Plastic Wrap (return clean to retaller)



No Tanglers (Hangers, Hoses, Wire, Cords, Ropes or Chains)



No Big Items (Electronics, Wood, Propane Tanks, Scrap Metal or Styrofoam – check willcountygreen.com for other options)



No Clothing Textiles or Shoes (donate)



No Food, Liquid, Diapers, Batteries or Needles



Put material in loose
- Not in Bags



No "to-go" food containers.

Pre-Cycle to Reduce Waste



When shopping, try to "Pre-Cycle." **Match the packaging of items you buy** with what is **currently recyclable**. Think about planning meals and buying in bulk when possible. Avoid single-use packaging, such as TV dinners, lunch in trays, K-Cups, and even water bottles.

In the spirit of less waste, bring a **refillable water bottle** wherever you go, shop resale, start a backyard compost pile, and plant a garden to supplement you're packaged foods. Lastly, consider asking an old school butcher to skip the polystyrene and package your meat in paper.

- Refillable Water Bottle
- _ Ceramic Mug / Thermos
- _ Steel or Bamboo Straw
- _ Cloth Napkin
- _ Reusable Lunch Box or Bag
- Durable, Washable Utensils
- Durable Bowls with Lids
- _ Fruit in its own skin (Bananas, Apples, Oranges, Clementine)
