Optional Activities:

Use Both Sides of school papers/photocopies whenever possible;

Collect & deliver clothes/shoes/books to Will County Textile Event (May 2024), or Will County Book event (week after Memorial Day 2024);

Compost a portion of food scraps in outdoor or indoor bin (vermicompost bin);

Perform 2 waste-free lunch days during the school year;

Host a recycled art fair to showcase turning trash into treasure;

Plant flowers or vegetables using vermicompost;

Plant a butterfly, flower or vegetable garden at school;

Clean-up litter on or around school grounds;

Cut energy use in your school with a lighting, HVAC or other notable project, or;

Perform a school waste audit with students and Will County educator.
