- Lights at Courthouse- Solution= Timers? Occupancy sensors?
- Auditor acts as compliance officer once policies are in place
- Sunny Hill remodeling has incorporated LED lights, high efficiency furnaces etc.
- Exception or clause of compliance for certain County Buildings- still under discussion

- Majority of energy & gas usage has been collected and will be discussed at March meeting- still waiting on some county rentals properties data

- Warehouse lighting retro-fits and parking lot lights at Sunny Hill are being worked on this month
- Difficult to maintain parameters of degrees and reaction times of heating & cooling systems
- E-blasts to be sent out to county wide employees

- County operations goals will be part of the county wide long term energy efficiency and conservation plan. The current draft of the LTECP lists the energy reduction of 10% over 10 years beginning in 2009 of existing buildings.
