restore FREE electronic recycling service to Will County residents. **Please bring your drivers' license. Limit 2 TVs per vehicle.** Closed all other days and times. Be aware that illegal dumping during closed hours will be prosecuted. The County is working with public and private sites to open more permanent locations with the same restrictions in order to comply with the provisions of the recently bid recycling contract. One-day collection events will also be offered.

The Will County Resource Recovery and Energy Division will host its annual textile collection event this week with assistance from USAgain and WJOL AM1340. Collection bins will be available during normal business hours on the



first floor lobby of the Will County Office Building. Items accepted include gym shoes, boots, shoes, pants, shirts and dresses as well as drapes, tablecloths, blankets, and towels. Items with stains, broken zippers, rips or missing buttons will be accepted for recycling. Cotton and polyester can be recycled into other items, such as insulation for homes, sound proofing for vehicles and much more!

The WJOL morning crew will be on-site on Friday, May 2 from 6am-9am to give local schools and businesses dropping off items a shout out for their recycling and reuse efforts! Goodwill will be on site on Friday to provide donation receipts for both textiles and home items such as lamps, picture frames, DVDs, utensils, plates, bikes, books and much more! Donate on Friday!.

Solar Energy in Will County

This home, located at 2949 Ferro Drive in New Lenox, cost just over \$13,000 to install after incentives. The panels and connection to the grid was done through <u>Carlson Solar</u>. The home is expected to generate more power than it needs during the day (unless running air conditioning) and that excess power goes to ComEd that offsets any power the home pulls through <u>net-metering</u>.

While OFF Deep Woods insect repellent VIII (25% DEET) was most effective upon application, Cutter lemon eucalyptus insect repellent was one of the two most effective at the four hour mark.
