Solar Goes Through the Roof









Not satisfied with having the largest solar roof tops in the state, Romeoville manufacturer, Magid Glove & Safety is building a 3.5 megawatt solar array, becoming the largest solar rooftop in the midwest! The rooftop array will consist of over 10,500 solar panels that will produce enough electricity to offset 575 residential homes (or 100% of the company's current needs). Convergence Energy is the project developer and Continental Electric, is Magid's engineering and installation partner. Installation begins soon!

Cut Plastic Use - Switch to Durable Refill Bottles

The University of St. Francis community eliminated the need for 11,607 water bottles in April by utilizing the 25 water bottle refilling stations located around the main campus, St. Clare campus, and the Plaster Center at the St. Bonaventure Campus.. This brings the 2018 savings up to 45,981 water bottles!

Will County switches to 50% Alternative Energy

Will County used to be home to two coal plants, but over the past decade, these have switched to Natural Gas electric generation plants. We are home to a Nuclear Power Plant, which generates electricity without air pollution issues. This past month, the County Board voted to improve the sources of electricity for County Buildings by choosing to make 50% of our power come from solar and wind generation. This will result in financial savings for the County while also cleaning the air!

If you are the kind of person that turns off the faucet when you brush your teeth and only runs the washer or dishwasher when it is full, because you respect our water resources, then be sure to take the car to the professionals for a wash. Letting the local car wash do the dirty work could save up to 100 gallons. They recapture the water instead of letting it run into the yard with oil and other contaminants, or worse, into the local storm water system.
