Fully Visible Solar Eclipse

Get ready for August 21, 2017. Not since 1918 has a solar eclipse been visible from coast to coast in the United States! This year's will be 90% visible in our area and 100% visible in southern Illinois! However, it is important to wear proper eye protection to view it. Learning More about our Trees

The Morton Arboretum recently launched a resource at <u>ChicagoRTI.org</u> to help communities around the area better understand the local tree canopy in hope of improving our quality of life. The data reveals that of the 157 million trees in the seven-county Chicago region, 60% are comprised of fewer than 10 species, which puts the tree canopy at risk should peets

establish areas within our region with the greatest need and interest for tree planting and stewardship.
