Recycle the Wine Bottle Corks

In 2008 a footwear company joined an alliance of businesses to collect and re-purpose natural wine corks. They are ReCORK, North America's largest natural wine cork recycling program. They have grown into a network of over 3,000 cork collection partners, planted more than 8,000 cork oak trees, and recycled over 110 million corks. With a fleet of over 3,000 vehicles, ComEd has set a goal to electrify half the fleet. ComEd will replace end-of-life internal combustion vehicles with plug-in hybrid and fully electric vehicles, reducing fuel and maintenance costs and creating savings that will be passed on to customers. By 2025, all of the company's light duty vehicles (LDVs) approaching the end of their life cycle will be replaced with electric vehicles, and all LDVs will be electrified by 2030.
