All American Recycling is providing a scrap metal dumpster

for unwanted metal that isn't taken in curbside recycling, such as hangers, bent nails, car parts, pipes, broken wrenches, metal



doors and more. Any financial proceeds from the scrap are donated to Sharefest for volunteers to do small repairs for residents with limited resources or suffering disabilities. In this way, scrap funds repairs, improving the community.
